

Hot Foil System Quick Reference Guide

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 **Requires the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine — the platform is too wide for the Big Shot.**

Step 1 · Set Up & Heat the Platform

1. Place the Hot Foil platform on the silicone platform station.
2. Plug the power cord into the platform. It will beep and all lights will briefly flash.
3. The platform heats for about 6 minutes. *While heating: the white timer light stays lit and the red light flashes.*
4. When ready, it beeps again, the red light turns solid, and the white timer button flashes.
5. Place the die flat-side down on the platform, then press the white timer button.

Step 2 · Assemble the Foiling Sandwich

Stack these layers on the platform, in this exact order:

1	Die — flat side down on the platform
2	Foil — shiny side down. Cut only the amount of foil you need to help conserve your supply.
3	Cardstock — Smooth white and two-tone cardstock produce the best results. Very thick cardstock is not recommended.
4	Green shim
5	Clear spacer shim

- Wait until the green light comes on (this takes a few minutes).
- Unplug the cord and remove the platform from the station.
- Keep the sandwich together and handle it carefully.

Step 3 · Run It Through & Reveal

6. Place the platform on your cut/emboss machine — no other platforms underneath.
7. **Slowly run it through the machine. Do not reverse the platform.**
8. Place the platform back on the silicone station.
9. Remove the shim and spacer plates.
10. Peel the foil away from the cardstock to reveal your image.

 **Dies get hot! Use the magnetic pick-up tool to move them safely while they cool.**

 **To continue foiling, plug the cord back into the platform and repeat the steps above.**



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
